## General Information

All short film entrants need to be submitted to YOH Fest by the **18th August**. The Short Film category finalists will be shown at the Short Film Festival in Mandurah. The winning entry will be shown at the YOH Fest Grand Final Drama night. Entries will become the property of YOH Fest to be used as appropriate for display or promotion.

**Unit 1AMPA** - The focus for this unit is **personal experience**.

**Unit 2AMPA** - The focus for this unit is **popular culture** such as that demonstrated by reality television.

**Unit 3BMPA** - The focus for this unit is **power and persuasion**.

## Rules & Regulations

- a) Work must be of the young people's own work, but entrants may consult and be assisted by teachers, parents and health workers.
- b) Presentations must not exceed the **10 minute time limit, including opening and closing credits (One point will be deducted for every minute the performance goes over time. Exceeding the time limit by 5 minutes or more will result in disqualification)**. Entries will not be penalised for going under this time limit, as long as the message is effectively communicated.
- c) All copyright guidelines must be adhered to.
- d) The use of unauthorised music, images and references are not permitted.
- e) Presentations must be of a PG Rating (anyone not sure on whether or not their content is of a PG Rating should visit [www.oflc.gov.au](http://www.oflc.gov.au) ).

- f) The health message must include relevant and current information and be presented in a positive and appropriate manner.
- g) Presentations must be in a DVD format.

## Judging Information

Entries will be judged on the following:

1. Innovation, creativity and communication of the message.
2. Construction of entry.
3. How effective the presentation is at communicating themes and messages to a wide range of social, cultural and economic groups.

- ✓ Fast moving, attention grabbing and visually engaging.
- ✓ Appealing to a wide range of social, economic and cultural groups.
- ✓ Original and innovative. Reinvent typical scenarios and settings.
