# CATEGORY INFORMATION

The YOH Fest dance category invites students to rock on to the stage with an **EIGHT minutes** dance routine that tells a story or delivers a message based around the YOH Fest health theme.

Entries aren't rewarded for spending a huge amount of money on sets, costume design and specialised training; instead, they are rewarded for being creative and thinking outside the box to deliver the health message, making YOH Fest an affordable option for all schools. Schools are encouraged to focus on getting the health message out there as creatively as they can!

### GRAND FINALS (WA ONLY)

All YOH Fest Dance entries compete in regional heats held across the State, with the top eight finalists going forward to compete at the WA Grand Final event hosted in Mandurah in October.

Finalists are announced after the completion of the regional heats in WA.

### NORTHERN TERRITORY

All YOH Fest Dance entries will compete in YOH Fest Northern Territory, with the winners announced at the conclusion of the evening.
